



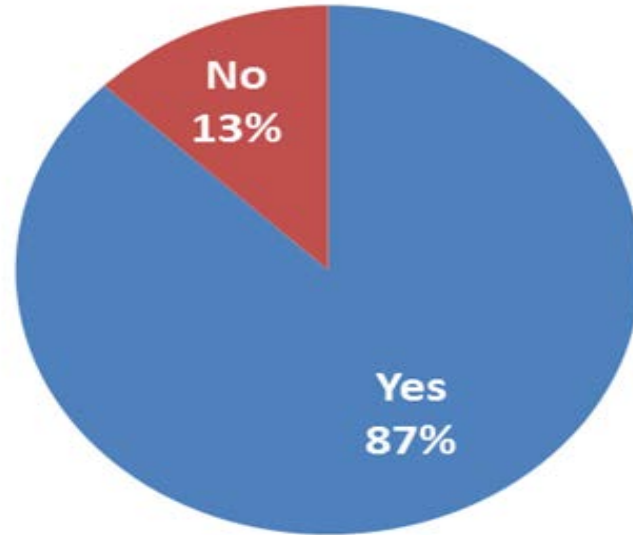

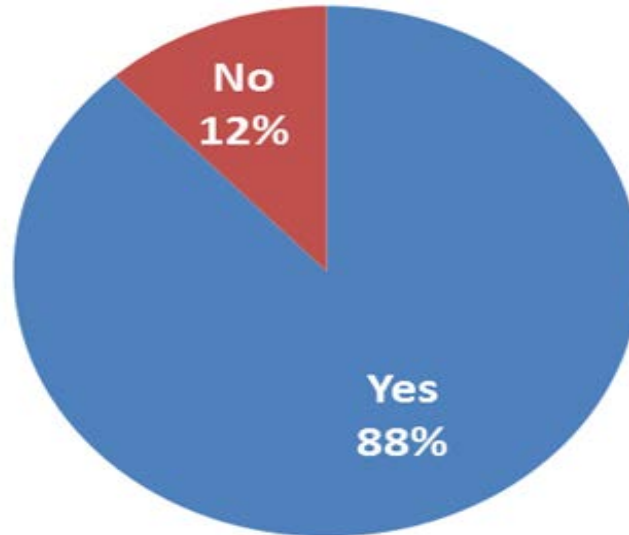
Triton Knoll One Off Construction Community Fund Consultation Results

- Questionnaire developed based on the results of earlier consultation in 2015
- Questionnaire available online at www.tritonknoll.co.uk.
- Hard copy questionnaire was mailed to properties within 3km of the landfall location, 5km of the TKES substation and 1km of the onshore cable route.
- Questionnaire responses open from 6 November to 4 December 2017
- Questionnaire deadline extended due to issues around Freepost envelopes.
- Drop in sessions held at 4 locations during November 2017.
- 110 questionnaire responses.
- Some additional informal responses also submitted.

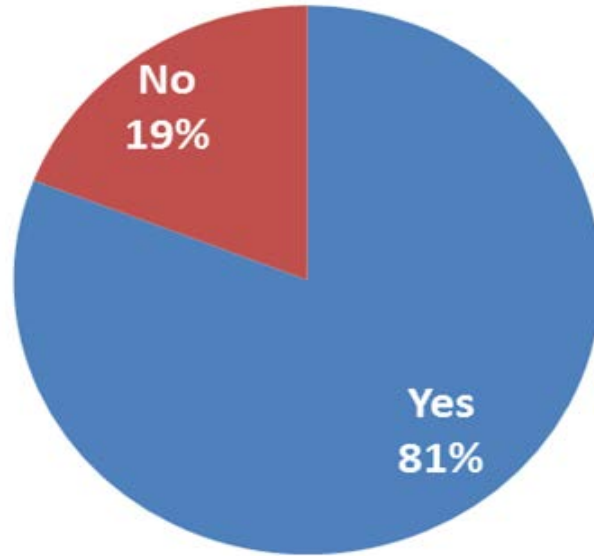
Do you agree with the four funding themes proposed?



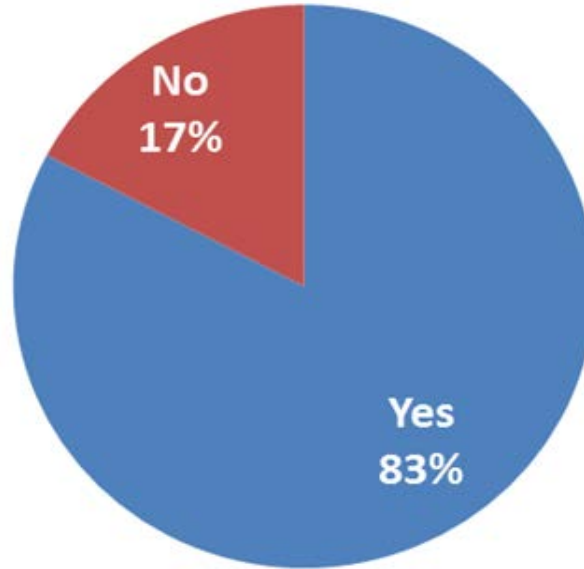
Do you agree with the proposed levels of support for "Small Projects" (£250 to £2,500) and "Large Projects" (£2,501 to £10,000)?



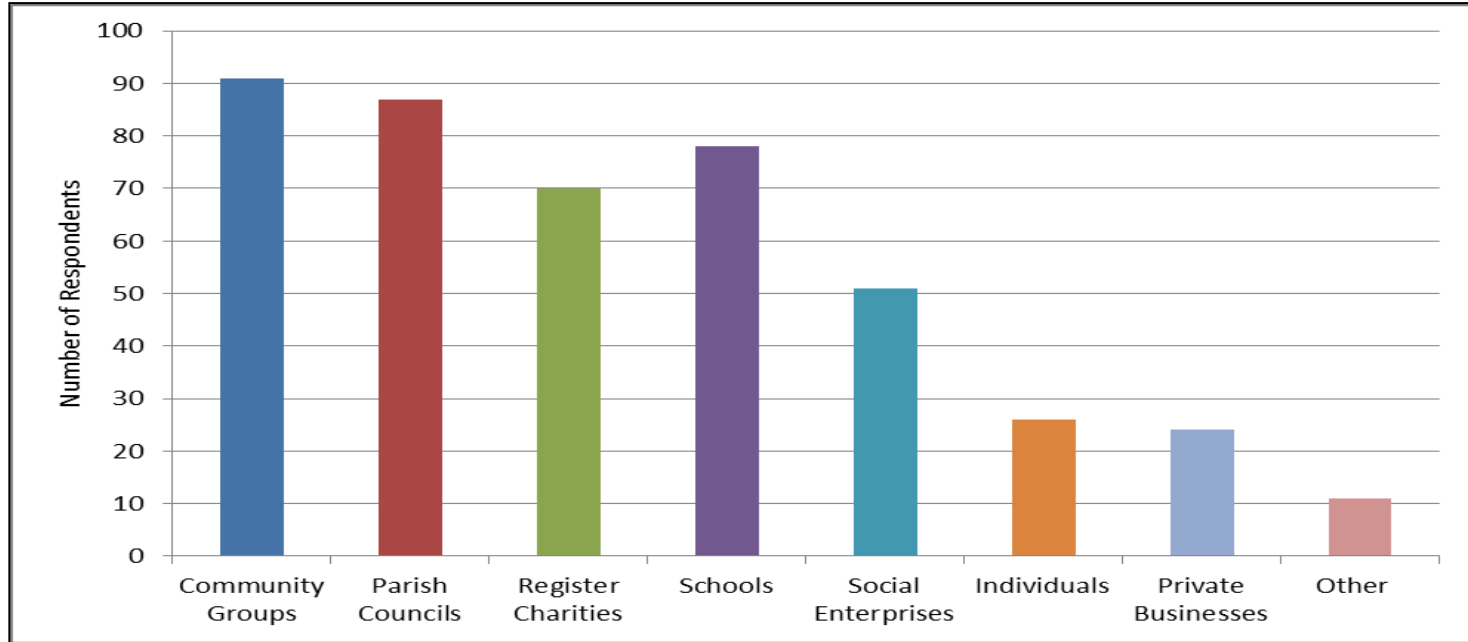
Do you agree with the proposal to incorporate an interest free loan option when supporting large projects?



Do you support the proposal to provide the options to support large projects for multiple years?



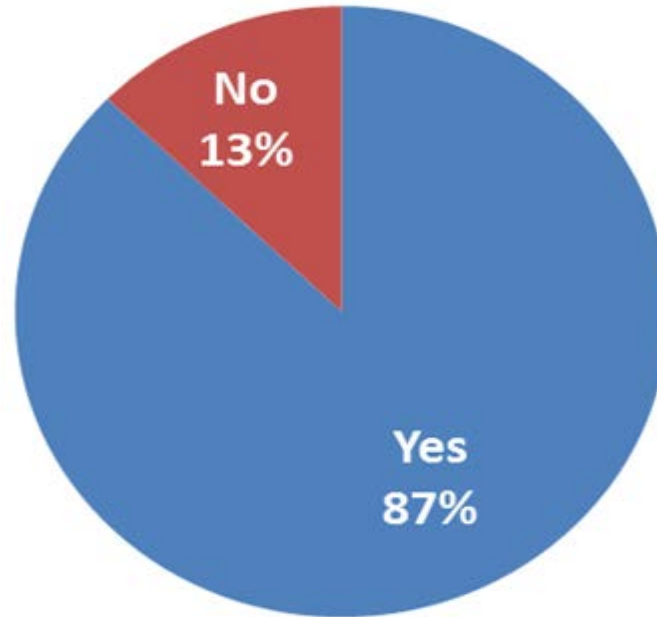
Which of these type of organisations you think should be eligible to apply to the fund?

Comments - Main themes for each topic

- **Funding Allocation** – Majority of comments in this area – Funds for the village hall. Only local people to benefit (not NHS, council, local authority). Fund small projects (Walking for Health Donnington). Fund creation and maintenance of cycle & foot paths. Broadband improvement. Road improvement and cleaning road signs. Fund environmental projects. Allow individual claims. Restore memorial plaque. Funds towards pre-schools. Better street lighting. Drainage fund.
- **Increase Fund** – double the proposed amount for projects. Issue with the size of the fund. £10,000 is not enough
- **Against** – disagree with: social enterprise, individuals, private businesses having access to the fund. Against wind farms.
- **Fund Administrator** – 1 comment unhappy with LCF. Questioning how much administration is paid in addition to the fund. Small number of comments highlighting local council / district council / parish council should be responsible.
- **Funding Area** – Anderby Creek and village need 50% of the fund as they are the most affected. Catchment area at the landfall is too large.
- **Electricity Bills** – reduction in electricity bills for those in the area.

Area of Benefit



Buffer of 3km around the landfall location at Anderby Creek

5km buffer around the substation location near Bicker Fen

A 1km buffer around the onshore cable route

Funding Themes

- Projects that improve opportunities for and / or encourage tourism;
- Projects that enhance quality of life for local people;
- Projects that contribute to vibrant, healthy, successful and sustainable communities;
- Projects that promote community spirit and encourage community activity.

A wide range of local groups are invited to apply to the fund while the following will be unable to make direct applications

- Individuals
- Private businesses
- County Councils
- District Councils

Eligible Projects

Small Projects
up to £10,000

Large Projects
£10,001 up to £50,000

Large projects could be supported over more than one year (maximum £50,000 in total)

Large projects could be supported in part or full by an interest free loan

This could help organisations grow to become more sustainable as well as recycling some of the funds so that even more projects could benefit.

2 Funding Rounds Per Year
(4 rounds across fund lifetime)

Fund Administrator

The Lincolnshire Community Foundation

An experienced, independent grant-making trust. Charity Commission registered (registration number 1092328). Providing good governance, and a fair and transparent grant-making process.

Decision-making Panel

Participants recruited based on experience, knowledge and skills, rather than geographical area represented. Panel places identified by the sector of the community that individuals represent e.g. voluntary sector, business, education, environment, younger people, older people etc.

Administration Fees
