

Modern Slavery Act 2015

Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement 2021

Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited ("the Company") owns Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm, a 857MW offshore wind farm located approximately 20 miles off the coast of Lincolnshire and 28 miles from the coast of north Norfolk.

The site is an operating offshore windfarm, with 90 wind turbines of 187 metres (614 ft) tip height above mean sea level.

Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited has appointed RWE Renewables UK Swindon Limited to provide services to it under a Management Services Agreement. Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited is committed to both the statutory requirements under the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and to acting with integrity in all its business dealings and relationships to have a zero-tolerance approach to Modern Slavery. This is a position which it expects all of its suppliers to respect and adopt.

Triton Knoll Offshore Wind Farm Limited has instructed RWE Renewables UK Swindon Limited, to

- (i) implement and enforce effective systems of controls to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place anywhere within its own business or in any of its own supply chains; and
- (ii) ensure that where it negotiates contracts with third parties in its name and on its behalf that such contracts provide suitable provisions relating to the systems of control that such third parties are taking to ensure that Modern Slavery is not taking place within their business and supply chains.
